



**Summary of Substantive Changes
between the 2010 and the 2016 editions of
NSF/ANSI 24 “Plumbing System Components for Recreational Vehicles”**

Presented to the IAPMO Standards Review Committee on May 16, 2015

General: The changes to this standard should not have an impact on currently listed products. The substantive changes are:

- Reduced the minimum allowable free waterway diameter of flexible drain systems from 1.25 to 0.625 in (see Section 18.2.1)

Section 1.3, Normative references and tools: Updated the normative references to reflect the most recent editions.

Section 18 Flexible drain system:

18.2 Design and construction

18.2.1 All fixtures shall have a minimum free waterway of a nominal 0.625 in (1.59 cm) diameter, except shower drains which shall have a minimum of 1.25 in (3.175 cm) diameter.
